

Great Plains Region / AVP Points System for Individual Players.

The system begins ranking players at the regional level based on the following.

- 1) Award the 1st place team with points equivalent to the number of teams in the tournament.
- 2) The second place team receives the total number of points earned by the 1st place team subtracted by 2. The 3rd place team receives the total number of points earned by the 2nd place team subtracted by 3. The process is repeated until there are no more points to allocate.

Example: 20 teams compete in tournament

1st Place 20 points
2nd Place 18 points
3rd Place 15 points
4th Place 11 points
5th Place 6 points

6th Place 0 points ($6-6 = 0$. Therefore 0 points are received.)

Example: 10 teams compete in tournament

1st Place 10 points
2nd Place 8 points
3rd Place 5 points
4th Place 1 point

5th Place 0 points ($1-5 = -4$. Therefore 0 points are received.)

This system benefits players that play in tournaments with larger participation. The theory being that the more teams entered into an event, the better the competition and the stronger the tournament.
