RULES USAV rules will be enforced. This division will be using a Volley-Lite volleyball. You will be allowed to serve inside the end line and a line will be marked and taped inside the end line. (6'6" into the court). The net height will be at 7'. The 10s, 12s, 13s, 14s are allowed to have a second toss per each service attempt. The tossed or released ball must land without being touched by the server before a new service authorization can be granted. Second service must happen within 5 seconds.

OFFICIATING Each team will be asked to ref....you need to supply 2 referees, 2 scorekeepers, and 2 line judges
Coaches should be assisting your team & be near the court, actively involved (especially for this age) *It is important to stay on schedule—please take care of your duties and you will need to provide your own whistles. The coin toss will be held with a captain from each team before the game begins.

WARMUP 2-4-4 minutes for the first games and 1-3-3 for subsequent games once everyone has played.
Shared court time for 2 min, 4 min of serving and hitting for serving team, 4 min of serving and hitting for receiving team, There is no shared serving, please provide your own volleyballs (remember we are using VolleyLite volleyballs....we should have some extras)
